6 Marks Of A Disciple

1. Application

Jesus said to the Jews who believed, "If you keep and obey My Word, then you are My followers for sure.³² You will know the truth and the truth will make you free."

John 8:31-32

2. Love

I give you a new commandment. You are to love each other. You must love each other as I have loved you. ³⁵If you love each other, all men will know you are My followers.”

3. Fruit

When you bear a lot of fruit, it brings glory to my Father. It shows that you are my disciples. John 15:8

4. Priority

“Anyone who comes to me must hate their father and mother. They must hate their wife and children. They must hate their brothers and sisters. And they must hate even their own life. Unless they do this, they can’t be my disciple. Luke 14:26

“Or suppose a king is about to go to war against another king.
